Sunrise Hwy to Exit 46- Carleton Ave North. Follow signs and continue to Carleton Ave. Take Carleton Ave North 3 traffic lights – Turn left onto Beaverdam Rd.

Sunrise Hwy West

To Carleton Ave North- Follow directions for Sunrise Highway above....

Southern State Pkwy

Southern State Pkwy East to Exit 43A. Bear right, then turn right at end of the end of the exit- Proceed to 1st Traffic Light turn left onto Carleton Ave (County Rd 17). Continue to the 2nd traffic light - Turn right onto Beaverdam Rd.

Long Island Expressway

L.I.E. to Exit 56 South Route 111. Bear left at sign Central Islip/East Islip- Wheeler Rd., Road changes to Carleton Ave. - Continue on Carleton Ave. approximately 2.5 miles to Beaverdam Rd. - Turn right.
